

TODAY, YES TODAY, is a most unusual day because it is a 3-in-1 recognition day throughout the world wide church, probably in the following order. It is Pentecost Sunday when we celebrate, remember, expect and receive the continued empowerment of the HOLY SPIRIT's ministry. Most all churches take note of this day and call it Pentecost Sunday. Secondly, it is Aldersgate Day when many Christians who respect the major contributions of John Wesley to Christianity and history celebrate the day Wesley was converted. This day is always celebrated on May 24th and thus it doesn't always fall on Sundays. Thirdly, today is Heritage Sunday. This day is a day calling each church to celebrate, remember and to expect the continued work of GOD's plan in their midst. I've had a few churches that used Heritage Sunday to somehow remember their history. So today, we are asked to remember, reflect and expect that Pentecost would have been part of our history and that what Wesley encountered 277 years ago would also be our experience of grace. To top that, I've been addressing the subject matter, "There's more to the Resurrection than Easter". Today, you should notice that the famous verses of scripture from the 2nd chapter of Acts actually deal with the Resurrection and not just the HOLY SPIRIT's ministry of revealing HIS presence to the infant church. That said, we must learn to better acquaint ourselves with truth from the gospel that interconnects CHRIST's resurrection with CHRIST also sending HOLY SPIRIT to be with those who are being saved through experiencing the Resurrection power of JESUS CHRIST. It's not just all one in the same, but all three working together to move us to where CHRIST would have HIS church in these days. We need all the Resurrection Revelation we can receive and in so doing move from the effects of death to the effects of life in the LORD's timing. We need Pentecost beyond description. Our lives are filled with something either from this world or the Kingdom of Heaven. I choose the HOLY SPIRIT! How about you? Then we each need our personal experience of an Aldersgate encounter with the LORD! I will explain that this morning. Are you ready to be where the Resurrection meets Pentecost on Aldersgate Street? You will be if your heart longs to know even more the extent of the LORD'S plan for your life and HIS life working through you to touch and influence this world. Blessings for the journey!!!
