We remember, therefore, his passion and proclaim his offering of his body upon the cross once for all. We give thanks for his resurrection from the dead and shout for joy at his ascension to the seat of power.

We watch and wait for the day when he will come in a cloud with power and great glory to gather the wheat into his granary and share with us the promised feast.
