John's Jottings

The Last One

This John's Jottings is the last for the GLIA. You are subjected to my rambling thoughts one last time. I hope that my writings have given some food for thought or at least some amusement.

I can hardly believe that I have been the pastor of Trinity for six years. These have been some very unusual years. These years were years of change and stress. The beginning of my ministry here was filled with hope. Attendance was increasing, and there was renewed energy.

Then COVID hit. Everything was suspended, including worship. Though unable to meet in person, we developed ways to worship together in spirit. We began electronic giving as a means for people to continue to give to the church. We recognized the need to upgrade our audiovisual capabilities so we could livestream services. Also, we have used this medium for Bible studies and other studies.

Though our in-person attendance remains about half the pre-COVID attendance, we have 10-20 views online each Sunday service. The studies have had 5-10 viewers. Streaming funerals online allowed family and friends who were unable to attend to participate. We may not know exactly how many, but we reached people through this medium.

Since COVID, we have not been able to have our big events, such as the Summer Splash and Fall Festival. Instead, we began moving to small group ministry. We began the T. a. G. group. Based on the Wesley Class Meeting, this group is for spiritual growth and transformation through mutual support and accountability. We also began a grief support group that meets every second Tuesday of the month at 11:00 AM. I hope these groups expand and more small groups are developed, as small group ministry is an effective and inexpensive way to reach new people.

We also recognized our organization was unwieldy and inhibited our ministry. Therefore, we reorganized with a twoteam approach instead of multiple committees. The administrative team serves all the administrative functions of the church, while the ministry team carries out the church's ministries. While we are adjusting, we should become more efficient in our ministries.

We have gone through a season of loss and grief. Many faithful members have died during these years. Many have lost family members who were not professing members but part of our church family. I do not dare to name them all because I will probably forget someone.

The past six years have been a time of joy. I cannot describe the elation I felt when the District Superintendent pulled out the Church Profile and I saw Trinity-West Columbia. After my experience in Laurens, coming to a place I knew well and loved was so healing. You do not know how much healing took place for Kay and me by being here.

I had the joy of baptizing Everly and Lyla Faye Branham. This was extra special because Kay and I taught Daphne in the nursery with Ashton. Of course, nothing can compare to baptizing Lizzie at the same fount where Ashton was baptized. Though it was the only one, joining Kelsey and Brandon as husband and wife was a great pleasure.

My biggest accomplishment was finally being ordained a full elder. Little did I know that when we joined Trinity in 1986, I would become an elder in the United Methodist Church while at Trinity. I could not have done this without your prayers and support. I thank you.


